APPENDIX I List of Economic Activities Allowed for Foreign Investment

Agriculture

- Cultivating, producing, processing, and marketing of seasonal agricultural crops (including tapioca and tobacco)
- Establishing plantations (including medicinal plants, coffee, tea, palm oil, horticulture, etc.) and producing, processing, and marketing of their produce

Livestock and Fishery

- Livestock breeding, processing, canning, and marketing of livestock and its products (including pig breeding and pork processing, etc.)
- Production and marketing of animal feeds, additives, supplements, and veterinary medicines
- Breeding, fishing, processing, and marketing of fresh-water and marine fish, prawns, and other aquatic organisms including fish fry, fingerlings, post larvae of shrimp, but not including breeding and production of fish and prawns in fisheries which have been reserved for research by the government
- Production, processing, marketing of all kinds of fish feeds

Forestry

- Production and marketing of basic construction materials, furniture, parquet, etc., using teak extracted and sold by state-owned economic organizations (to be carried out jointly with state-owned economic organizations)
- Production and marketing of carvings and handicrafts made of teak that has been extracted and sold by state-owned economic organizations engaged in the extraction and marketing of the same
- Production, processing, and marketing of hardwoods (other than teak), bamboo,

cane/rattan, and other forest produce

• Production and marketing of construction material, furniture, and other products using hardwoods (other than teak), bamboo, cane/rattan, and other forest produce

Mining

- Exploration, exploitation, production, and marketing of non-metallic industrial minerals, such as coal, limestone, gypsum, etc.
- Marble quarrying and production and marketing of marble blocks and slabs
- Carrying out other quarrying industries and marketing of products thereof

Industry

Foodstuff

- Manufacturing and marketing of bakery products, including biscuits, wafers, noodles, macaroni, spaghetti, etc.
- Manufacturing and marketing of all kinds of confectionery, including those of sweets, cocoa, and chocolates
- Preserving, manufacturing, canning, and marketing of other food products
- Processing, manufacturing, and marketing of oils and fats from vegetables, animals, and other substances
- Manufacturing and marketing of soft beverages, aerated and non-aerated products
- Manufacturing and marketing of malt and malt liquors and other brewery products

- Manufacturing and marketing of electrical household goods and appliances, such as refrigerators, air-conditioners, hot plates, irons, cookers, fans, and other homeuse appliances

APPENDIX II State-Owned Economic Enterprises Directly Involved in Foreign Trade

Myanmar Agriculture Service (formerly Agricultural Corporation)

Export

Rubber, spices, ginger, gram, red kidney beans, millet, sorghum, and miscellaneous agricultural produce

Import

Fertilizers, insecticides, specific agricultural chemicals, small farm implements, and seeds for distribution to farmers

Myanmar Timber Enterprise (formerly Timber Corporation)

Export

All timber, timber products and other minor forest produce, including ivory and agarwood (aloe wood)

Foodstuff and general goods, textiles, paper, stationery, photographic stores, medicines and medical stores, vehicle spare parts and tyres, machinery, construction and electrical goods

APPENDIX III Procedures for Export and Import and Customs Clearance

1. Procedures for Export and Import

An enterprise permitted under the Foreign Investment Law has to be registered as an exporter/importer, upon business requirement, with the Export-Import Registration Office, Directorate of Trade.

Export Procedure

- A registered exporter must obtain an export licence, in conformity with the rules and regulations laid down by the Directorate of Trade; no fee for issuance of export licence is required.
- An irrevocable letter of credit has to be opened by the buyer through a correspondent or an acceptable bank at the Myanmar Investment and Commercial Bank.
- The vessel to be shipped has to be nominated by the buyer.
- The Myanmar Port Authority has to be contracted for the shipment of cargo that is to be shipped on an f.o.b. basis.
- Pre-shipment inspection, if required, will be conducted by the Inspection and Agency Services with respect to specification, weight, quality, and packing.
- Details of the cargo, such as shipping bills, other shipping documents, and customs pass, etc., must be presented to the Myanmar Investment and Commercial Bank for transaction.

Import Procedure

- A registered importer is required to open a foreign exchange account at the Myanmar Investment and Commercial Bank in order to apply for an import licence from the Directorate of Trade.
- In applying for an import licence, the application shall be attached with the sale contract and/or proforma invoice mentioning detailed specifications, mode of packing, and delivery phasing.
- An import licence fee of 5 per cent on the c.i.f. value of the goods is to be paid to the Customs Department within one month of the issue of the licence.
- An irrevocable letter of credit (L/C) has to be opened by the importer at the

Myanmar Investment and Commercial Bank.

• If the purchase is made on an f.o.b. basis, the importer has to secure insurance from the Myanmar Insurance and freight booking from the Myanmar Five-Star Line.

 After receiving shipment advice from suppliers, the importer has to arrange for the clearance of goods.

2. Customs Clearance Procedures for Export and Import

Export

On shipment of export commodities shipping bills must be submitted to the Customs Department together with the following documents:

- (a) Export Licence
- (b) Shipping Invoices
- (c) Packing List
- (d) Form E (declaration for shipment of goods to countries outside Myanmar)
- (e) Shipping Instructions
- (f) Letter of Credit or Contract and other relevant documents
- (g) Exporter's Registration Certificate

Import

Under the existing rules and regulations all incoming consignments of goods must be cleared through the Customs Department under the Bill of Entry. The Bill of Entry is to be accompanied by the following documents:

- (a) Original Invoice
- (b) Freight Bill
- (c) Insurance Bill
- (d) Original Bill of Lading or Airway Consignment Note
- (e) Packing List
- (f) Import Licence

Customs duty is payable according to the tariff schedule based on assessed value. Together with the customs duty, a commercial tax is levied on the imported goods based on the landed cost, which is the sum of the c.i.f. value, port dues calculated at 0.5 per cent of the c.i.f. value, and customs duty. These taxes are collected at the point of entry and at the time of clearance.

Seven-eighths of the customs duty paid on goods that could be easily identified will be refunded when such goods are withdrawn from the country again under the drawback facility. Goods on which drawback is claimed must be re-exported within two years from the date of importation. The time may be extended up to three years if there is sufficient reason for such extension.
