Phiphat Tangsubkul has a doctorate in Law from the University of Aix-Marseille in France and has completed a course in Special Studies on the International Law of the Sea at the Columbia University School of Law, USA. He received a certificate from the Hague Academy of International Law in 1975. He was an observer from the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) at the first session of the Sea-Bed Committee in 1973. He has also been a visiting lecturer at the Naval War College, Thailand. In 1977, he was a Research Fellow at the Institute of Southeast Asian Studies in Singapore, where he conducted a research project on "ASEAN and Problems of the Law of the Sea". More recently he was a Research Fellow at the Environment and Policy Institute, the East-West Center, Honolulu, where he worked with the legal group of the Ocean Project. He is now a lecturer in the Faculty of Political Science, Ramkhamhaeng University, and a Research Associate at the Institute of Asian Studies, Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok, Thailand.

His involvement with the problems of the law of the sea and resource development in Southeast Asia includes service as a lecturer/researcher and an observer at UNCLOS III; he has also been panelist and co-ordinator for several international workshops and conferences on the Law of the Sea.
