Dr Hanns J. Buchholz has been Professor for Cultural Geography at Hannover University since 1981. Between 1970 and 1972 he visited East Asia, conducting research. He has also repeatedly visited the South Pacific since 1977. He has published several scientific texts on applied geography and articles on town development and on the new Law of the Sea as it applies to the South Pacific. He is the author of *Population Mobility and Residential Behaviour within the Social Geographical Pattern of Hong Kong* (Paderborn: Schöningh, 1978); editor and co-author of *Australia-New Zealand-South Pacific* (Frankfurt: Fischer, 1984); and co-author of *Hong Kong — Metropole of Finance and Economy, Development Pole for China's Alteration* (Braunschweig: Westermann, 1985). He is also a member of the Scientific Committee on Geography of the Pacific Science Association.
